Our next Saturday Work day will be March 4th.



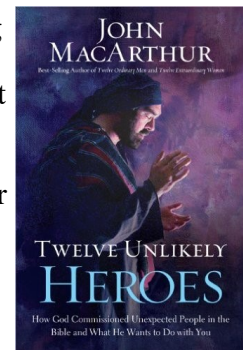

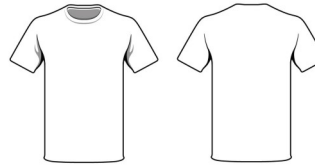
350 Cake Mixes!
