
We have needs! Opportunities include:

- **Good with Computers?** We need: Web page Admin; Newsletter producer; Worship folder preparation and production.

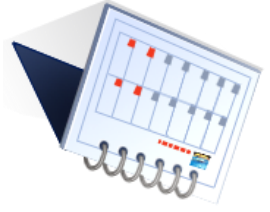
