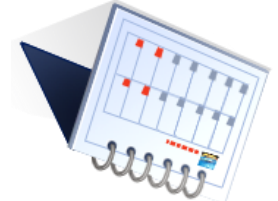


Enter from Honey Ridge Road and come all the way to the back. Bring a chair for comfort. We will have bottled water and a Porta-Potty.
