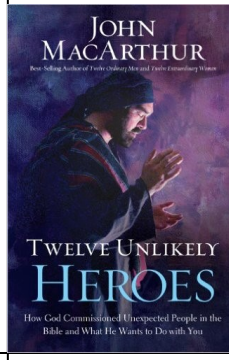


Right now we are installing wiring and boxes for our electrical rough in. Bring wire cutters, drill and hammer and 6' ladder!

## The Key is Peace in our \_\_\_\_\_

Miriam and Aaron criticized Moses because of the Cushite woman he married (for he had married a Cushite woman). <sup>2</sup> They said, "Does the LORD speak only through Moses? Does He not also speak through us?" And the LORD heard it. <sup>3</sup> Moses was a very humble man, more so than any man on the face of the earth.

<sup>4</sup> Suddenly the LORD said to Moses, Aaron, and Miriam, "You three come out to the tent of meeting." So the three of them went out. <sup>5</sup> Then the LORD descended in a pillar of cloud, stood at the entrance to the tent, and summoned Aaron and Miriam. When the two of them came forward, <sup>6</sup> He said:

"Listen to what I say: If there is a prophet among you from the LORD, I make Myself known to him in a vision; I speak with him in a dream.

<sup>7</sup> Not so with My servant Moses; he is faithful in all My household.

<sup>8</sup> I speak with him directly, openly, and not in riddles; he sees the form of the LORD. So why were you not afraid to speak against My servant Moses?" <sup>9</sup> The LORD's anger burned against them, and He left.

<sup>10</sup> As the cloud moved away from the tent, Miriam's skin suddenly became diseased, as white as snow. When Aaron turned toward her, he saw that she was diseased <sup>11</sup> and said to Moses, "My lord, please don't hold against us this sin we have so foolishly committed. <sup>12</sup> Please don't let her be like a dead baby whose flesh is half eaten away when he comes out of his mother's womb."

<sup>13</sup> Then Moses cried out to the LORD, "God, please heal her!"

<sup>14</sup> The LORD answered Moses, "If her father had merely spit in her face, wouldn't she remain in disgrace for seven days? Let her be confined outside the camp for seven days; after that she may be brought back in." <sup>15</sup> So Miriam was confined outside the camp for seven days, and the people did not move on until Miriam was brought back in. <sup>16</sup> After that, the people set out from Hazeroth and camped in the Wilderness of Paran. Numbers 12:1-16 HCSB

<sup>15</sup> "If a fellow believer hurts you, go and tell him—work it out between the two of you. If he listens, you've made a friend. Matthew 18:15 The Message

<sup>16</sup> If he won't listen, take one or two others along so that the presence of witnesses will keep things honest, and try again. Matthew 18:16 The Message

<sup>17</sup> If he still won't listen, tell the church. If he won't listen to the church, you'll have to start over from scratch, confront him with the need for repentance, and offer again God's forgiving love. Matthew 18:17 The Message

<sup>9</sup> Love must be without hypocrisy. Detest evil; cling to what is good. <sup>10</sup> Show family affection to one another with brotherly love. Outdo one another in showing honor.

<sup>11</sup> Do not lack diligence; be fervent in spirit; serve the Lord. <sup>12</sup> Rejoice in hope; be patient in affliction; be persistent in prayer.

<sup>13</sup> Share with the saints in their needs; pursue hospitality. <sup>14</sup> Bless those who persecute you; bless and do not curse. <sup>15</sup> Rejoice with those who rejoice; weep with those who weep. <sup>16</sup> Be in agreement with one another. Do not be proud; instead, associate with the humble. Do not be wise in your own estimation.

<sup>17</sup> Do not repay anyone evil for evil. Try to do what is honorable in everyone's eyes. <sup>18</sup> If possible, on your part, live at peace with everyone.

<sup>19</sup> Friends, do not avenge yourselves; instead, leave room for His wrath. For it is written: Vengeance belongs to Me; I will repay, says the Lord.

<sup>20</sup> But If your enemy is hungry, feed him. If he is thirsty, give him something to drink.

For in so doing you will be heaping fiery coals on his head.

<sup>21</sup> Do not be conquered by evil, but conquer evil with good.
