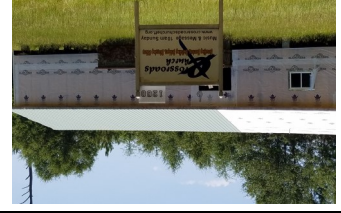


FYI!

SuperWow in Toccoa! Thank you for the opportunity to go to Camp. We had a Blast! We will have some video next week!



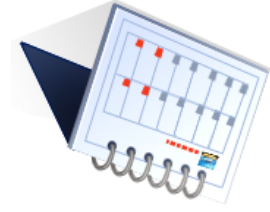
