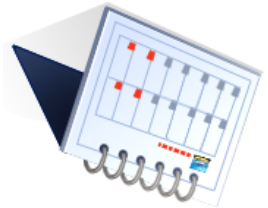

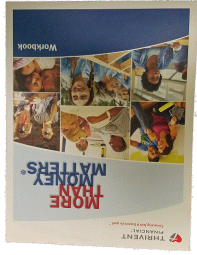


BACKPACKS for Appalachia
