**Saul's Lack of Discipline is R**\_\_\_\_\_\_<sup>8</sup> Saul was furious and resented this song. "They credited tens of thousands to David," he complained, "but they only credited me with thousands. What more can he have but the kingdom?" <sup>9</sup> So Saul watched David jealously from that day forward.

<sup>10</sup> The next day an evil spirit sent from God took control of Saul, and he began to rave inside the palace. David was playing the lyre as usual, but Saul was holding a spear, <sup>11</sup> and he threw it, thinking, "I'll pin David to the wall." But David got away from him twice.

<sup>12</sup> Saul was afraid of David, because the LORD was with David but had left Saul. 1 Samuel 18:8-12 HCSB <sup>28</sup> Saul realized that the LORD was with David and that his daughter Michal loved him, <sup>29</sup> and he became even more afraid of David. As a result, Saul was David's enemy from then on. 1 Samuel 18:28-29 HCSB

<sup>3</sup> When Saul came to the sheep pens along the road, a cave was there, and he went in to relieve himself. David and his men were staying in the back of the cave, 4 so they said to him, "Look, this is the day the Lord told you about: 'I will hand your enemy over to you so you can do to him whatever you desire." Then David got up and secretly cut off the corner of Saul's robe. <sup>5</sup> Afterward, David's conscience bothered him because he had cut off the corner of Saul's robe. <sup>6</sup> He said to his

men, "I swear before the LORD: I would never do such a thing to my lord, the LORD's anointed. I will never lift my hand against him, since he is the LORD's anointed." 7 With these words David persuaded his men, and he did not let them rise up against Saul. 1 Samuel 24:3-7 HCSB

 $^{9}$  But David said to Abishai, "Don't destroy him, for who can lift a hand against the Lord's anointed and be blameless?" 10 David added, "As the LORD lives, the LORD will certainly strike him down: either his day will come and he will die, or he will go into battle and perish. <sup>11</sup> However, because of the LORD, I will never lift my hand against the LORD's anointed. Instead, take the spear and the water jug by his head, and let's go." 1 Samuel 26: 9-11 HCSB
