3 BENEFITS TO GIVING ONLINE

1. You are taking a step of faith - When you sign up to give online you are deciding in advance to faithfully give. God always blesses that kind of faith!
2. You will simplify your life - You won't have to remember whether you gave this month or need to send in an offering by mail when you're on a trip.
3. You will help the church - Every person who gives through automatic giving makes our record keeping much easier.

Online Giving can be accomplished by using your bank's "Online Bill Pay" system. Simply send Crossroads Church a "payment". The "Payee" would be Crossroads Church, and the "Account Number" would be your designation (Tithes etc.). Most banks have a place to make this a recurring payment. Using your bank's online system to pay bills saves Crossroads Church the cost of credit and debit card processing fees and can be easier for you to manage.

School began a few weeks ago and so began the opportunity to bless families. We will plan on a delivery every other month the last week of October.

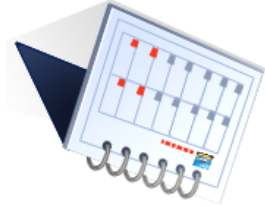
